Directions To The Doubletree Guest Suites Philadelphia West

From the Airport

Take Interstate 95 South to Route 476 North. Follow 476 North to Exit 20 -- Germantown Pike West (the last exit). Merge with Germantown Pike -- at the third light turn right onto Hickory Road. Go to first light and make a left onto Fountain Road. Hotel is at the first stop sign on your right.

New York/ New Jersey Turnpike

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 6 -- Pennsylvania Turnpike. Go west on the Turnpike to Exit 333 -- Norristown. Following signs to Plymouth Road, turn left at the first light onto Plymouth Road. Turn right onto Germantown Pike at the next light. Proceed on Germantown Pike and turn right onto Hickory Road at the second light. Go to first light and make a left onto Fountain Road. Hotel is at the first stop sign on your right.

Washington DC, and Wilmington, Delaware

Take Interstate 95 North to Route 476 North. Take Route 476 to Exit 20 -- Germantown Pike West. At the third light, turn right onto Hickory Road. Go to first light and make a left onto Fountain Road. Hotel is at the first stop sign on your right.

Route 476

Take Route 476 to Exit 20 -- Germantown Pike West. At the third light, turn right onto Hickory Road. Go to first light and make a left onto Fountain Road. Hotel is at the first stop sign on your right.

From Downtown Philadelphia

Take Interstate 76 west to Exit 331B -- Plymouth Meeting/Route 476. Take Route 476 north to Exit 20 -- Germantown Pike West. At the third light, turn right onto Hickory Road. Go to first light and make a left onto Fountain Road. Hotel is at the first stop sign on your right.

Public Transportation from 30th Street Station

Walk to Schuylkill Ave. and JFK Blvd. and catch the 125 bus to King of Prussia/Valley Forge. Arrive at the Gulph Mills Station take the Trolley to the Norristown Transportation Center. Arrive at the Norristown Transportation Center and take the 98 bus towards Willow Grove Park. Get off the bus at Fountain Drive and PM Exc. Campus 3 walk 6 minutes to the Double Tree Hotel.
